### About GRA

The Global Renewables Alliance (GRA) was established at COP27 as an umbrella organisation bringing together six leading renewable energy associations: the Global Wind Energy Council, the Global Solar Council, the International Hydropower Association, the Green Hydrogen Organisation, the Long Duration Energy Storage Council and the International Geothermal Association.

GRA was the driving force behind the combined renewable energy intervention at COP28 in Dubai, marking the largest private sector renewable energy mobilisation for renewables to date.

We are committed to a future powered by clean, secure and just energy—renewables. Through campaigns including Double Down, Triple Up – 3X Renewables, and engagement at major international moments including New York Climate Week and COP, GRA advocates for accelerated renewable deployment globally.

### The Opportunity

We are seeking an experienced and strategic Head of Communications (Interim – 12 Months) to lead GRA's communications function during an important period of growth and delivery.

This role combines strategic communications leadership with hands-on execution. You will lead campaigns, manage stakeholder relationships across a global coalition, oversee agencies and suppliers, manage budgets and lead a small communications team.

A strong understanding of renewable energy and the wider energy transition landscape will be important to success.

### Key Responsibilities

- Lead and deliver GRA's communications strategy across global and regional priorities.

- Develop compelling narratives and position GRA as a credible voice on renewable energy and the energy transition.
- Lead the development and execution of communications campaigns across media, digital, events and stakeholder engagement.
- Build and manage relationships across member associations, private sector partners, media and policymakers.
- Manage communications agencies, consultants and external suppliers.
- Lead and develop the communications team to deliver high-quality outcomes.
- Own and manage the communications budget and ensure effective delivery against objectives.
- Oversee public-facing communications, including content, brand, website and social channels.
- Support communications around key international moments including Climate Week and COP.

### **About You**

You are a strategic communications leader with experience shaping narratives, building influence and delivering high-profile campaigns in complex international environments.

You will likely bring:

- At least 5 years' experience in communications, public affairs, media, campaigns or related leadership roles.
- Strong understanding of the renewables, energy, climate, sustainability and public policy landscape.
- Demonstrated experience managing teams, stakeholders, suppliers and budgets.
- Strong campaign and media experience in complex international environments.
- Excellent communication and influencing skills.
- Experience working across international and multi-stakeholder environments.
- Excellent written and verbal English.

- Experience working in energy transition, climate, renewables or related sectors.
- Exposure to international advocacy and policy environments.
- Experience supporting communications around major international events.
